COMMUNITY GRANTS

Requirements

- Organizations must be federally tax-exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the IRS Code with non-private foundation status or an equivalent government entity under section 170 (c)(1).
- Organizations must be located in an area where Cox Communications does business within our West Region which includes the following markets: Las Vegas, Orange County, Palos Verdes, Phoenix, San Diego, Santa Barbara, Southern Arizona and Sun Valley, Idaho. - Grant recipients will acknowledge Cox Charities' support publicly.

Limitations

Cox Charities Community Grants will support:

- Program-related expenses, including activities, materials and expenses related to the program.
- Programs and initiatives that impact the areas of: K-12 STEM Education, Conservation & Sustainability, Digital Equity and any specific local needs identified by each market.

Cox Charities Community Grants will NOT support:

- Organizations or programs that discriminate based on race, gender, gender identity, sexual orientation, age, religion, national or ethnic origin or physical disability.
- Political causes, candidates, organizations or campaigns.
- Organizations whose primary purpose is to influence legislation.
- Operating expenses (staff salaries, overhead, or other recurring program or administrative costs)
- Religious organizations for general operating support, sanctuary construction/renovation or mission-focused work. (We do consider applications from religious organizations with 501(c)(3) status providing project-specific social services/programs not limited to a religious affiliation.)
- Sponsorships, conferences, seminars, fundraising events (i.e. dinners, golf tournaments, walk/runs, benefits, raffles, tickets, tables, etc.)
- Individual public, private or charter schools.
- General operations for the provision of healthcare/therapy services, basic needs, or socialization/recreation.
- Scholarships for individual students or nonprofit organizations for the purpose of granting scholarships benefitting an individual.
- Capital Campaigns
- Endowment Funds.
